

**CPBL Field Work Policy**  
**Effective Date: January 9, 2012**

Clifton Park Baseball enjoys the use of some of the best playing fields in the Capital District. To maintain and preserve the quality of our fields, the league has adopted the following field work policy:

1. The Commissioners of Fields and Facilities are responsible for organizing and directing all field maintenance, upkeep and improvement projects.
2. Spring, Summer and Fall Cleanup. Division directors for each age group are responsible for recruiting a sufficient number of volunteers to assist with field cleanup prior to the beginning of each season.
3. Fall closing. At the conclusion of the fall season, division directors for each age group are responsible for recruiting a sufficient number of volunteers to assist with closing the fields for the season.
4. Lining the fields. It is the responsibility of individual teams to ensure their fields are properly chalked/lined prior to the start of play.
5. Post-game field maintenance. Both teams are responsible for raking the field and removing trash from dugouts at the conclusion of each game.
6. Special projects. From time to time, the Commissioners of Fields and Facilities may determine that extra field work is required to ensure that the fields remain in good condition and safe for play. In recognition of the substantial benefits that travel and all star teams receive from the league and the significant field use by these teams, upon request, all travel and all star teams are required to assist in up to two special field maintenance projects prior to or during the team's season.
7. If a particular division or team fails to comply with this policy, the board may take such action as it deems necessary to protect the fields and ensure that the burdens of running the league are fairly distributed, including but not limited to imposing additional field assessments in the current or future seasons or restricting a particular team/division's ability to use the fields.
